Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to inform you about the forthcoming update to our behaviour policy which is due this month.

As you know, at Greenleas our approach to managing behaviour is based in restorative practice / therapeutic thinking, which is the expected and endorsed approach by the local authority and associated outreach team, Jigsaw. In response to feedback from parents, children and staff, we recognize that whilst the underpinning principles are broadly understood, more detail around specific consequences, and the escalation process would offer more transparency, and set clearer expectations for all parties.

This half term, we are working to set out this clear escalation process in consultation with our staff, so that we can ensure everyone can have their training refreshed on the Inset day in April. This will also be included in our revised behaviour policy, which will be taken to governors for approval on 14th May. An extension to our current behaviour policy will be issued at our governing board meeting on March 4th.

In line with our current practice, we do expect children to show consistently good behaviour in order to be able to attend extra curricular events like school trips and PTA events. Therefore if your child is currently being supported with their behaviour choices through strategies such as structured lunch, you will be unable to book such events, for example the upcoming Movie Night at Kestrel Way for them unless agreed through discussion with the class teacher.
