Forest School Sessions

This half-term, children in Goldfinches and Starlings are able to benefit from Forest School sessions with a trained Forest School Leader.

Forest School is a fun, exciting way to learn in an outdoor woodland setting. It is proven to improve children’s confidence, self-esteem and communication skills, as well as giving them an opportunity to have lots of fun! The children also develop skills in team work, using tools safely and learning how to look after the natural world. All activities are carefully planned, risk-assessed and very closely supervised. Activities are likely to include exploring, natural art and crafts (including using tools such as bow saws, hammers, and peelers), woodland games, den building, climbing, heating water with a Kelly kettle and collecting wood for a camp fire.
